- Only PDF files will be accepted.
- Participants of NCAIA2025 are invited to submit detailed abstracts for presentation at the conference. These abstracts must be written in English and should be a minimum of three pages. They should include the following: the title, author names and their affiliations and emails, an abstract, keywords, an introduction, the main results, a conclusion, and references.
- All papers must be submitted through the CMT Microsoft submission system at https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/NCAIA2025 If submission through not possible, please send your extended abstract platform is to: icaitc@tmp.umc.edu.dz An automatic confirmation email will be sent to authors for each successful submission.
